YEAR IN REVIEW - 2025

2025 has been a year of moving forward, victories, and preparation. We rescued more families in 2025 than we did in 2024 from the Pakistan brick kilns.

We received resettlement approvals for both our Afghan refugee families into Canada and we successfully renovated our two sex trafficking recovery homes in Eswatini, Africa.

I am grateful for all of our donors and supporters that have made this year our best year yet.

3 Areas of Focus

What began in 2024 as a simple yes to help a couple of Afghan girls running from the Taliban has turned into saving lives in multiple arenas. We have focused this year on persecuted refugees, those trapped in slavery in the Pakistan brick factories, and those suffering from human trafficking in Africa.

We will continue to work in these three areas building strength within our teams locally and internationally. We believe that 2026 will be our best year with more Pakistan rescues slated for the first quarter of the year than we did in 2025 alone.



Impact in 2025

Through the generous support of our donors we were able to rescue 34 individuals making up 7 families from the Pakistan brick factories. Not only were we able to rescue the families, but also we provided them a sustainable business so that they never have to go back into slavery again. Also, each family that we have rescued has continued to be successful and prosper.

We have successfully cared for 8 Afghan refugees making up 2 families. One family of 7 that we have been hiding in different locations since we began the rescue caring for them on a monthly basis, and another young girl, 24 years old that we are also caring for on a monthly basis until we can settle both families into Canada.

It's amazing what a simple "yes" can accomplish.

The Statistics Are Not In Our Favor

Innocent lives are continually being taken all across this world and sold for their bodies, their labor, or other exploitative reasons. There are around 50 million people who are trapped in modern day slavery in the world today which correlates to 1 out of every 162 humans. This is a staggering number.

Even though these numbers seem daunting, we will continue to fight, and believe that we can make a difference in the geographic areas where God has given us to labor.






We have teams and partners on the ground in Pakistan, Eswatini, and Tanzania.

2025


Revenue Derived from Individual and Corporate Donations

A GREAT 2025

- 34 people rescued from Pakistan Brick Kilns making up 7 families.
- Cared for 8 Afghan refugees on a monthly basis in different locations in Pakistan, including paying for their rent, food, water, medical, transportation, and anything needed to sustain them.
- Successfully renovated our two recovery homes for human traffic victims in Eswatini, Africa. This was to prepare to receive 32 children under the age of 18 years old that have been the victims of human trafficking.
